#### **PAST EVENTS**



<u>School Bus Registration</u> - All **new** students for the 2018-2019 school year need to register in order to be picked up by their school bus in the fall. Any students who were registered this year only need to register again if their land location or contact information has changed. **Registering online is quick and easy**. Doing so now will ensure your child is placed on the proper bus for the first day of school. Not registering on time will result in delays in having your child assigned a bus. It may take several days into the new school year to arrange their busing.


