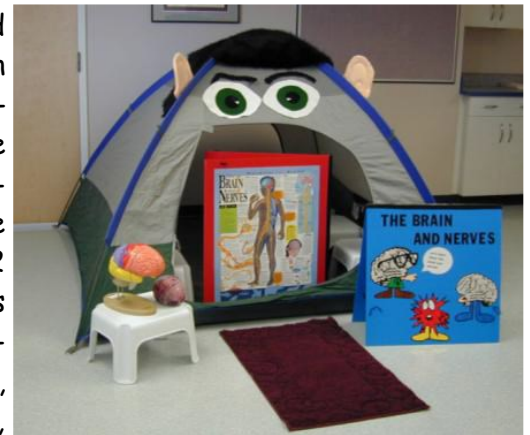

Brain Walk - On Monday, May 27 Canwood Public School and Wapiti's Canwood Library Branch welcomed Saskatchewan Health Authority educators Jennie Knutsen and co-worker Larissa Swityk-Conacher to the school gym for an informative "Brain Walk" program. Students from Grades 1-6 moved between 10 brain walk stations spending approximately five minutes at each. Station 1 was the brain and nerves, station 2 was frontal lobe - problem solving and emotions, station 3 was parietal lobe - sense of touch, station 4 was temporal lobe - memory, hearing and smell, station 5 was occipital lobe - vision, station 6 was cerebellum and brain stem, station 7 was alcohol,



drugs, and your brain, station 8 was what happens if you hurt your brain, and station 9 was how to take care of your brain. Finally, station 10 focused on how to have healthy minds, and included reminders for healthy eating, socializing, getting enough sleep, exercising, anger management, and more. 
